FROM THE PASTOR:

At the Palm Sunday Masses, after the proclamation of the Passion of Our Lord Jesus Christ, I made the following statement:



"As your Pastor, I ask your prayers for the Church, the Body of Christ. Pray for the Church's purification in these most difficult times.

How devious are the ways of Satan, the Father of Lies, who has filled with poison the minds and hearts of some within the Church who are called to the ministerial priesthood. Someone once said: 'The heart of man is the place the devil dwells in: I feel sometimes a hell within myself.' How true this must be for those who have betrayed a sacred trust. May God have mercy on them as they are held accountable for their deeds of darkness.

We, your priests, Fathers Mark, Joe and I, feel the pain of this tragedy. Pray for priests. Pray for Bishops.

Most especially, we pray for those within the Church who are the victims of abuse, young children and adolescents in particular - God's little ones. We pray that their deep mental and spiritual wounds may be healed by the action of Christ's charity.

It has been said that the Church is not possession of the kingdom, it is the struggle for it. But it is a struggle consoled by the promise that the gates of hell will not prevail against it. The Church in these times is suffering a crucifixion. It may take a crucified Church to bring a crucified Christ before the eyes of the world.

A philosopher, Blaise Paschal, once said: 'Jesus will be in agony even to the end of the world. We must not sleep during that time.'

Do not doubt the power of God. Do not doubt the power of love. God is so powerful that He can direct any evil to a good end. Beyond the cross is resurrection. Christ is our hope."

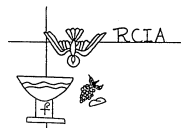
CEMETERY NOTICE

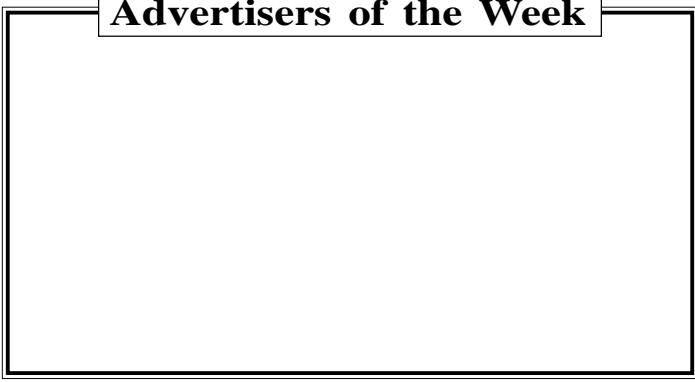
