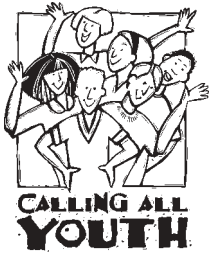

PROLIFE UPDATE: PROLIFE BILLS DIE

Two pro-life bills that passed the Indiana Senate with over-whelming majorities died in the House when House Public Policy Chairman Bob Kuzman (D-Crown Point) refused to give the bills a hearing. The bills were S.B. 138, ban on funding for human cloning, and S.B. 486, requiring abortion clinics to make ultrasound available for women prior to opting for an abortion. The recent defeats add to the growing list of pro-life legislation stopped cold by Rep. Kuzman. Mike Fichter, IRTL executive director, stated that Kuzman has been the key to killing one pro-life bill after another over the past three legislative sessions. (Lifeline Report – May 2002)

### LIFE TEEN REFLECTION

Although we returned last Sunday, World Youth Day remains in me. I can still see the diverse faces traveling the subway cars; I can still hear the voices of youth singing praises to God in various languages; I can still feel the awe of joining over 800,000 people partaking in the Eucharist with Pope John Paul II on Sunday. I will certainly NEVER BE THE SAME. Other highlights for me include:

catechesis with a Cardinal and two Archbishops, a teen holding me on his shoulders so I could see our Holy Father in the Pope mobile, Mass with Fr. Mark at a parish close to the hotel, prayer time in the hotel hallway before bed, teens begging to spend time in adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, everyone from our group reaching out to be Christ to each other and people they didn't even know, walking 10 miles to Downsland Park with our overnight gear for the Papal vigil and witnessing the miracle of rain turning to sun at the beginning of Mass.

A dear friend used the word "survivor" to describe the WYD experience. It truly was 6 days of Catholic Survivor. We not only survived, but we grew in many ways. Despite dehydration, long lines waiting for transportation, mediocre food, heat, and stress, I would not change a single thing; for the whole experience led me to deeper faith which results in more humble service to our Savior Jesus Christ. To all who helped with our trip and prayed for us, I am grateful. To each of you who shared the experience with me, I am eternally beholden. Cindy

We find this necessary because we need to begin to accumulate funds to help us pay for the following: a new school roof, Spiritual Center and rectory roof, organ repair and school boiler replacement. Some parishioners, having completed their building campaign pledge, will see this as an opportunity to continue giving in support of needed improvements for the maintenance and upkeep of the parish plant.
