**PETER'S PENCE**

My dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Our faith tells us that love of God is inseparable from love of others. As the Holy Father wrote in his Apostolic Letter 'Novo Millennio Ineunte' which marked the close of the Great Jubilee Year:



"The century and the millennium now beginning will need to see, and hopefully with still greater clarity, to what length the dedication of the Christian community can go in charity toward the poorest. If we have truly started out anew from the contemplation of Christ, we must learn to see Him especially in the faces of those with whom He Himself wished to be identified: 'I was hungry and you gave me food; I was thirsty and you gave me drink; I was a stranger and you welcomed me; I was naked and you clothed me; I was sick and you visited me; I was in prison and you came to me' (Mt 25:35-37). This Gospel text is not a simple invitation to charity: it is a page of Christology which sheds a ray of light on the mystery of Christ. By these words, no less than by the orthodoxy of her doctrine, the Church measures her fidelity as the Bride of Christ". (#49)

This weekend, June 26-27, we will hold at all Masses in the diocese the annual Peter's Pence collection. This collection enables the Holy Father to respond to requests for emergency funds for our neediest brothers and sisters throughout the world - those who suffer due to war, oppression, disease and natural disasters. Such assistance is rapid, bypassing as it does the bureaucratic time lapse often encountered as governments attempt to mobilize their own, sometimes meager, resources.

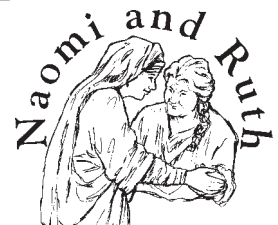

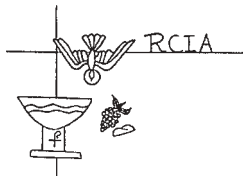
