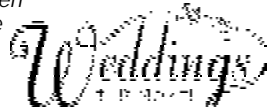

Legacy of Faith

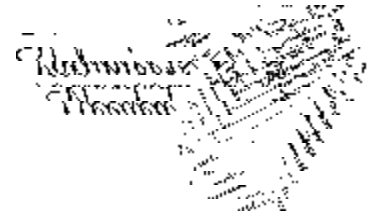

LET'S PROTECT OUR CHILDREN AND YOUNG PEOPLE

There has been some decline in the level of publicity concerning the scandal of sexual abuse of children by certain members of the clergy. However, a decline in public expressions of outrage does not mean that we can or should reduce our efforts to protect children and young persons from the evils of abuse. It does not mean that we can or should reduce our concern for those who may have suffered the trauma of child abuse, whether recently or long ago. To abuse a child is to sin. Our pastoral response to the occurrence of such grave sin must remain constant and consistent.

The Diocese of Fort Wayne-South Bend remains committed to upholding and following its guidelines, policies, and procedures that were implemented for the Protection of Children and Young People. These can be viewed at the Diocese's website, www.diocesefwsb.org.

If you have reason to believe that a child may be a victim of child abuse or neglect, Indiana law requires that you report this to civil authorities. If you or someone you know was abused as a child or young person by an adult, you are encouraged to notify appropriate civil authorities of that abuse. In addition, if the alleged abuser is or was a priest or deacon, you are encouraged to contact Father Robert Schulte, Vicar General of the Diocese of Fort Wayne-South Bend, at P. O. Box 390, Fort Wayne, Indiana 46801, or at (260) 422-4611. The Diocese is committed to helping prevent the abuse or neglect of children and young people and to assisting those who claim to have suffered harm as a result of such abuse.

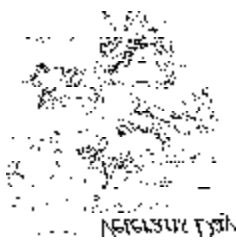

PNEUMONIA SHOTS AVAILABLE NOVEMBER 14TH

Can't get a flu shot? If you would like to get a pneumonia shot instead, we will have them here at St. Vincent's thanks to Parkview Hospital. Typically, a one-time dose of the vaccine is all that is needed, so check with your doctor first to see if you already had the pneumonia shot. If you have not, the vaccine will be given after the 9 a.m. and 11 a.m. Masses on Sunday, November 14 in the Church Conference Room, west wing of Gathering Space. The pneumonia shot will be administered to seniors, age 65 and older, at no cost. If you are under age 65 and would like to receive the pneumonia vaccine, the cost is \$35. CPR/AED TRAINING

SACRAMENT OF THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK

At all the Masses on the weekend of November 13 and 14, (except the 6:00 p.m. Life Teen Mass) we will be administering the Sacrament of the Sick. Parishioners who are seriously ill or greatly weakened due to old age or facing major surgery are candidates for the sacrament. If you would like to



be anointed, you are asked to sit at the end of the pew in either of the two sections along the main aisle or you may sit in one of the front seats designated for the disabled. Ushers will be of assistance to you. The priest will go to you for the anointing ritual which follows the homily. It would be helpful, if you plan to be anointed, to call the church office informing us of your intention.

BEREAVEMENT SUPPORT GROUP

In a time of loss it is important to know that there is a place where you can be with others who understand your pain. This is a time when being with others who have walked their own path of grief may be of comfort and offer us solace in a way that our families and friends cannot give.
