FREDERIC OZANAM STAINED GLASS WINDOW

BAPTISMAL PREPARATION CLASS

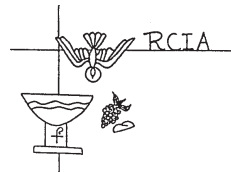

EDUCATION FOR MINISTRY PROGRAM 2006-2008
