Father Joe is leaving us after six years of dedicated service. Congratulations are in order, for Bishop D'Arcy has appointed him pastor of Most Precious Blood Parish, Fort Wayne. As associate pastor here at St. Vincent's, Fr. Joe has touched the lives of many parishioners. We have all grown to appreciate his kindness and gentleness, and we will miss him. Now taking on the responsibilities of a pastor, we wish him well and will keep him in our prayers. His appointment is effective mid-July, and we are making plans for a farewell reception. Replacing Father Joe is Father John Cramer, currently associate pastor of St. Matthew Cathedral, South Bend. Father Cramer spent a summer here while a seminarian back in 2001. I know you will warmly welcome him.

Alas, another change. Cindy Black, our very capable and effective youth director, has accepted an invitation from Bishop D'Arcy to be the Diocesan Director of Youth Ministry. This is a big step for her, but we know that her years of dedicated service in our Life Teen program have prepared her well for this new responsibility. Cindy, you are in our prayers, and, of course, we will be working with you as you serve the parishes of the diocese. Plans are tentative for a party for Cindy which will take place on Sunday, July 9, following the Life Teen Mass.

REKINDLE THE FIRE – COME AND PRAY WITH US

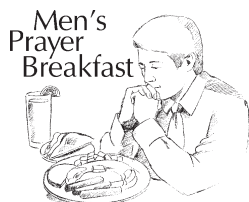

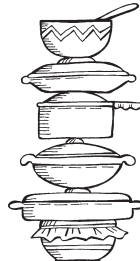
GUIDE BOOK & DIRECTORY ADVERTISING OPPORTUNITY
