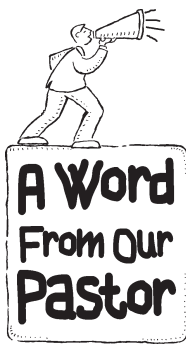
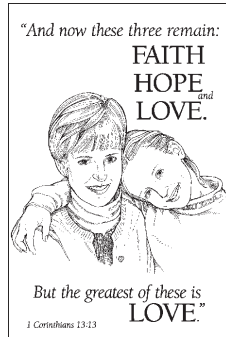

FROM THE PASTOR

You are invited to visit our parish grade school today for an open house from 2:00 – 4:00 p.m. as we celebrate the 50th anniversary of the establishment of the school.

With the support of the parishioners, Father Lawrence Fetting, pastor from 1953 until his death in 1974, opened the school on September 4, 1956. Because the economy was good, it was a good time to build. Three Adrian Dominican nuns staffed the school along with one lay person. The nuns were paid \$60 per month, the highest salary paid to teaching nuns at that time.

The school continued to expand; however, there were concerns whether it could remain open due to financial constraints and a shortage of nuns. In just ten years, the school grew from 180 students to 919 students in 22 classrooms. Efforts to raise funds to support the school were successful and, by hiring lay teachers, the school was able to remain open.

We are proud of our parish grade school as it continues to offer an excellent academic program and maintain a strong Catholic identity. I am grateful to Mrs. Guffey, the principal, and Mrs. Kleber, the vice-principal, for their strong leadership, along with a dedicated and excellent faculty. Our custodial and kitchen staffs deserve our praise as well as the Home and School Association, representing the parents, and the School Board.

When you visit the school when classes are in session and see the smiling faces of the children, you know it is all worth it. A very special moment is when all the children gather weekly for a school Mass. We are very grateful to God, who continues to shower His blessings upon us. Happy Anniversaries!

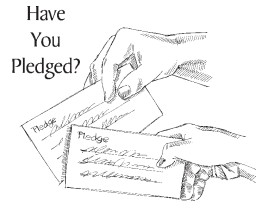
CATHOLICISM REVEALED

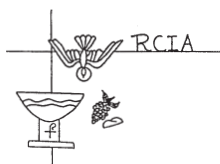
CO-SPIRITUAL DIRECTOR DISCERNMENT
