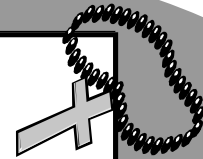

**Field Agent Report...**

If you haven't visited the Knights of Columbus Web site in a while, I encourage you to do so the next time you're online. There are many exciting features on www.kofc.org, but there are two that I wish to make you especially aware of.

The first is our member testimonial area, titled "Stages of Life." In this multi-media area, six "real-life" stories are told - stories of people at different stages of their lives. Chances are one of them will sound a lot like you. These people talk about how their Knights of Columbus agent took the time to demonstrate for them the need for life insurance in their lives. I'll be happy to do that for you and your family as well.

The second is our Life Insurance Calculator. This handy, easy-to-use online tool was developed to allow you, in about 15-20 minutes, to estimate the amount of life insurance coverage you need. The information you'll be asked to provide will be basic (the type most folks would tend to have at their fingertips), and secure (it's intended to be used solely for the purposes of the online calculator - the Order won't capture it or share it with anyone, including me!). I stress that the number you'll receive is an estimate, based on the basic information you provide. It's not intended to take the place of the free, professional needs analysis that I'll be happy to provide for you and your family.

## ***Pro-Life Report...***

### **Ultrasound Initiative**

#### **The Vision**

Those Pro Choice people who favor aborting babies in their mother's wombs have one very big enemy. There is something out there that will change the minds of 85% to 95% of the women who are contemplating abortion. There is a way that most of the abortions committed in this nation can be stopped. There is a way that we can help to eventually eliminate abortions completely. The identity of that powerful method is known as the Ultrasound machine.

This device enables a mother-to-be to actually SEE the life that is within her body in real time. She might see her baby move. She might see her baby kicking and not just feel those kicks. #### **The Action**

Now we come to the good part. The Knights of Columbus of Indiana can actually help destroy the abortion industry by taking part in the procurement of Ultrasound machines. Supreme has agreed that any Council that raises enough money to pay for half of an Ultrasound machine will see an equal amount donated by Supreme.

It is very difficult for one Council to raise that much money by itself. That is why the Indiana State Pro Life organization of the Knights of Columbus is proposing that all the Councils join together in raising the funds necessary to purchase one or more of these marvelous machines. By having all Councils working together they will not have to work against each other, drawing from the same populace. Your Indiana State K. of C. Pro Life group is proposing that ALL Councils begin working together for the goal of purchasing 5 Ultrasound machines to be used near the abortions facilities in Indiana that as of yet do not have one. With 174 Councils in the State we could easily share in the cost of providing these much needed baby saving machines.

Your Pro Life staff has already negotiated with a company that will sell them to us for \$27,000 of which our half would be \$13,500. That means when Supreme matches our total we could buy one of these miraculous machines.

### ***St. Vincent's 'American Heritage Girls'— Welcome to our Parish...***

St. Vincent's American Heritage Girls is the new scouting organization for the girls of our parish and the surrounding community. We welcome girls from all religions to join us in "Faith Service Fun". Discernment for our AHG program began in the Spring of 2010 when several parents were searching for an alternative to the secular scout program that existed at St. Vincent's. AHG was founded in Cincinnati in 1995 with the premise that God is the center of our lives. The AHG mission statement is "Building women of integrity through service to God, family, community and country."

American Heritage Girls is similar to the Boy Scouts of America where the girls are exposed to a well rounded curriculum, earn merit badges and service stars. The troop, which consists of girls from Kindergarten through 12 grade, meet every third Tuesday to work on badge criteria and service projects. The troop is divided into squads and they meet at least once a month.

The Knights of Columbus helped us kick off our first troop meeting in style: the Fourth Degree Knights performed our flag ceremony and answered questions afterward. The girls were mightily impressed! The Fourth Degree will honor us again at our first annual Patriot 5K Family walk/run on May 20th at Salomon Farm Park. They will also help with parking at the event. Many thanks for the donation of the March Pancake Breakfast proceeds. The girls and their families really enjoyed helping you!

The St Vincent American Heritage Girls look forward to working with and helping the Knights of Columbus with their efforts of embracing our Christian values and encouraging family involvement.

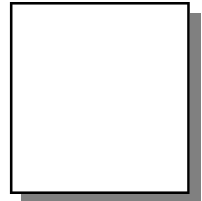
